



  - Six participants each received \$40,000 in funding










# **Education and Professional Development**

## Partnership with Ukrainian Canadian Congress

- First Cohort:
  - 22 Ukrainian newcomers enrolled
  - Expected graduation: June 2025
  - o All graduates will be offered employment opportunities
- Second Cohort:
  - o 30 Ukrainian students started in April 2025
  - Expected graduation: June 2027



- 328 Beyond Borders recipients






# Red River Métis Culture, Heritage and Language Program (Cont.)
