1. Arrival and Registration

When you arrive at Assiniboia Downs, the main lobby is your first stop.

Citizenship Card is Essential: Please have your Red River Metis Citizenship Card ready. It is required for entry and will be scanned to register you.

Registration Process: Once scanned, our team will confirm your delegate status and direct you where to pick up your name tag and AGA kit.

Safety & Security - A Note for All Attendees: To ensure a safe and comfortable environment for all our Citizens, Elders, and children, please be aware that large bags may be subject to a quick security check upon entry. To help speed up the entrance process for everyone, we encourage you to bring only essential items. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe and welcoming space for our community to gather.

2. Parking and On-Site Transportation

General Parking: The main parking lot is available for all Citizens.

Golf Cart Shuttles: For your convenience, golf carts will be running to escort Citizens from the main parking lot to the front doors. Priority is given to Elders, those with mobility needs, and families with young children.

Accessible Parking: Designated accessible parking is available in the south lot for vehicles with a provincial handicap pass.

Shuttle Service: For those staying at partner hotels, a shuttle service is available. The drop-off and check-in point is located in the main lobby of each hotel.



3. Seating and Viewing

Seating is organized across multiple levels. All satellite locations will have full audio and video feeds from the Main Hall.

Main Floor Hall: Reserved for specific delegates and those with pre-registered mobility needs (wristband required).

General Seating: Available in the Main Level Red River Metis Pavillion, the Lower Level, and the Second Floor. Seating in these areas is first-come, first-served.

Dedicated ASL Location: The satellite viewing location on the Second Floor includes a dedicated space for American Sign Language (ASL) interpretation. (Please see Registration to register for this service.)

Elders' Lounge: Located on the north side of the Main Hall, this lounge is a quiet space for Elders and their escorts to rest and enjoy light refreshments (wristband required). There will also be reserved seating just outside of the lounge, and at front stage for Elders and their escorts.

4. Services for Citizens

Information Booth (Lobby): Your central point for general questions, media check-in, and the Lost & Found for children.

First Aid (Lobby): A clearly marked First Aid station is located in the lobby for any medical needs. If you have an emergency – please advise a staff member and if possible attend to the Information Booth in the Lobby for assistance.

Lost Children Protocol: The Information Booth is the designated site for lost children. Should a child be separated from their family, please report it to the Information Booth immediately so staff and security can be notified.

Citizen Inquiry Form (Information Booth): Have a question for an MMF department? Fill out an inquiry form and drop it off to be forwarded to the right team.

CRO Bus (Main Entrance): The Central Registry Office bus will be parked outside the main entrance for Citizens needing assistance with renewals or Harvesting needs.

Health & Wellness Van (Outdoor Area): The mobile Health and Wellness van will be on-site to provide clinical services.



Refreshment Stations: Coffee, tea, water, and light snacks will be available throughout the day.

5. Special Events & Activities

Tradeshow (Third Floor): Open all three days. Visit over one hundred booths from MMF Departments, affiliates, and Métis-owned businesses.

Mini AGA for Kids (Ages 6-12): Held all weekend in the outdoor tent, this is a fun, interactive space with Red River Métis games, crafts, and Michif lessons.

Métis Market (Outdoor Area): Shop for official merchandise and artisan goods at the Red River Métis Marketplace, located in a large tent on the east tarmac.

IWS Rainbow Auction (Third Floor): Support the Infinity Women Secretariat's Bereavement Fund for a chance to win incredible prizes. Donations can be dropped off in the Tradeshow area.

Pickle Contest: Drop off your sealed jar of homemade pickles at the Information Booth before noon on Saturday, Oct 18.

"An Evening Remembering 'Big' Al Desjarlais" (Saturday Night): Join us in the Main Hall for a special tribute concert celebrating the life and music of a Red River Métis icon.

Family Night (Saturday Night): At the same time as the concert, head to the lower level for a Rummy and Cribbage tournament and games for children.




