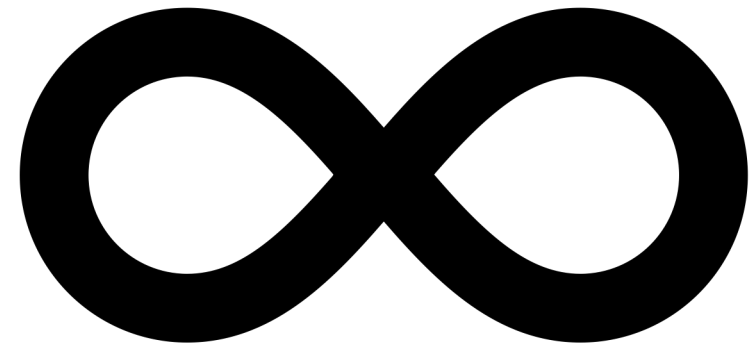

November 16, 2022

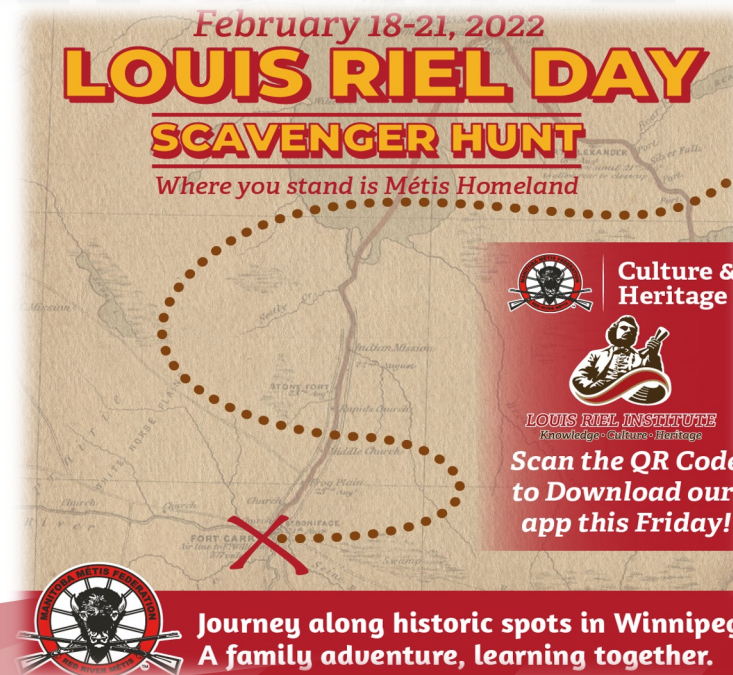

Engagement sessions coming Fall & Winter 2022-2023

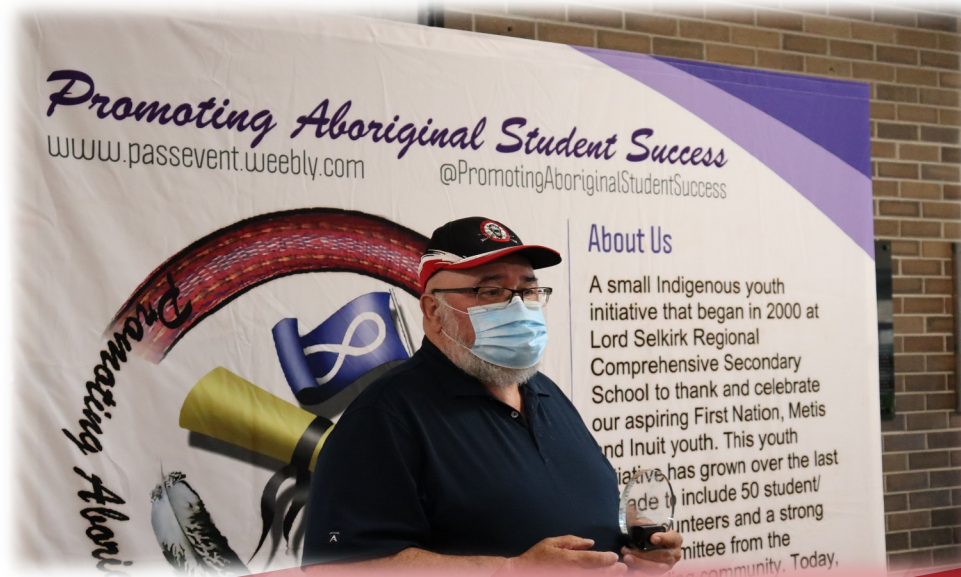
The Department received funding from the Government of Canada's Canadian Heritage Department
