Background

- The Sixties Scoop is a child welfare policy developed and implemented in the early 1950s and lasting well into the early 1990s
- Policy separated Métis children from their families and communities
- Many lost their identity and Métis rights



Our Collective Journey

- 2019 A series of engagements led to a national "What We Heard" Report
- 2020 Sixties Scoop Department is formed
- 2021 The department launches the Sixties Scoop Wellness Centre

- The Federal Court and The Federal Court of Appeal have denied the MMF's intervenor status request in the Métis and Non-Status Class Action lawsuit against the Canadian Government
- MMF will communicate with Survivors on the next steps soon
