


Culture & Heritage Report






Department Overview

 This is the first year that the department of Culture & Heritage has operated as a stand-alone department. We now have five staff: A Director and four program support staff.

• We now staffed with a Director and five program support staff.

 The Department is building capacity and securing funding for cultural events. We are partnering and collaborating with other departments and the Louis Riel Institute to promote and preserve Red River Métis culture and heritage.



Past Cultural Events and Promotion

- We had a very successful National Indigenous Peoples' Day again this year on June 21 approximately 1500 people came out to Selkirk Park to celebrate Métis culture with us.
- With our partners in Métis Employment and Training, Métis Community Liaison Department and the Louis Riel Institute, we had a wonderful Elders and Youth Gathering from August 29-30 with Red River Métis Elders and youth from all over the province.
- The Métis Music Van continues to make its rounds, sharing Métis music and culture everywhere it goes. Unfortunately, the van has been less active in the past few months due to some health issues I've had, but we are hoping to be back on track in the near future!








Culture & Heritage Newsletter and Events Calendar
